Take This To Heart

General Principle

Good-Good Works, Including True Full Spiritual Servanthood are the
FRUIT Not the ROOT, the EFFECT Not the CAUSE of Salvation.

Specific Case

Going to Church Doesn't Make a Person a Christian Any More Than Going to
a Garage Makes a Person a Car.

However Some Unbelievers Need Community Before They Will Consider
Conversion (Ask Bob Schalit When You See Him in Heaven, IF.....).
