Come join us as we are learning to trust and wait on God to triumph.







#### **Gin's Fresh Cranberry Walnut Muffins**

3 WW points each Makes 14 – 18 muffins

- 2 ripe bananas
- 1/3 c. apple cider
- 1/4 c. skim milk
- 1 egg
- 1 t. vanilla
- 1 c. all purpose white flour
- 1/2 c. wheat flour
- 1 t. soda
- 1/4 t. salt
- 1/3 c. sugar
- 2 c. fresh cranberries
- 1/2 c. chopped walnuts

In a mixing bowl, using an electric, cream together bananas, apple cider, milk, egg and vanilla. In a separate bowl, combine flours, soda, salt and sugar. Slowly add dry ingredients into mixing bowl on low speed. By hand, stir in cranberries and walnuts. Spray paper baking cups with non-stick cooking spray and fill with mixture. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes.
