Good works including water baptism are a fruit but not the root of salvation.

Warning Label: Times of euphoria/happy feelings based on + circumstances (Acts 8:36-38) come/go in the lives of all human beings including Christians. So, we must remember our faith is rooted in facts NOT feelings! Grace-given spiritual/eternal realities given to us thru the grace of God/Gospel of Christ transcend any/all circumstances now in us or around us on Earth (1 P 1:3-9).
