


Tanglewood Bible Fellowship

If you were unable to attend the Women of Tanglewood Summer Salads Get Together on July 14th, here's what you missed: a beautiful song by Sonja Skinner; a great salad buffet; yummy cookies; sweet fellowship; an informative slide show presentation of events and activities; and discussion about future potential ladies' Bible studies. There were two forms handed out to each woman present to cast a vote, give an opinion, and learn and choose how to be involved.

As a result, we have some dates to save, some activities to sign up for, ladies eager to help out, and events to start planning. The first women's activity is set for **Friday, August 7th**, at Strung Out (The Bead Shop) at 713 W. Walnut, Duncan. **You MUST sign up to attend, as space is limited.** This will be a jewelry making party with snacks provided. You will need to bring your own drink. The class is FREE, but jewelry making materials must be purchased by you at Strung Out.

We may start "shopping" for our jewelry project at 5:00, but instruction will not start until after the store closes at 5:30. You can see many completed jewelry projects on her Facebook page. At a later date, we plan to have a mother/daughter class.

In **September**, we will have a party at the Sow's Ear, Ginny's cabin, at Lake Humphries. We are looking at the dates the **12**th – **15**th. September's weather looks like a stinker. October 10 and 11, Saturday and Sunday, we will be heading back to Echo Canyon Spa and Resort in Sulphur, Oklahoma. After our trip last year, to Echo Canyon, this retreat is back by popular demand. Our first pick of a weekend in September was booked up, which is probably a good thing because that weekend's weather is predicted stormy. We will have dinner in the 5-star dining room. The menu is beef filet, duck breast (or chicken), halibut, potatoes, vegetables, homemade bread, a spectacular dessert and signature drink. Snacks, drinks and breakfast are inclusive. Tentatively, the first week of **November**, we will host a "Big Event" with guest speaker, Dr. Cheri Strange, Doug and Meg Strange's daughter-in-law. Our meal will be a catered and tickets will be sold. We encourage inviting guests to this event.

So far, according to the returned surveys, there are a couple of classes suggested with some new dates and times. We plan to get this kicked off the first of September.

Spicy Chicken Rigatoni

1 T olive oil 1/4 T crushed red pepper 1/8 t salt 1/8 t ground black pepper 3-4 cloves garlic, chopped 2-3 chicken breasts, sliced



In a large skillet, heat oil over medium heat. Add red pepper, salt, pepper, and garlic. Saute it long enough to let it caramelize. Add chicken and saute until cooked through.

1 lb. dry Rigatoni – cook according to package directions.

Add to the chicken mixture:

3/4 c. jarred Marinara sauce 1/2 c. jarred Alfredo sauce AND Cooked Rigatoni

Top with grated Parmesean cheese and serve with toasted garlic bread
