Dear Women of Tanglewood,

In mid-December, I took on the huge task of setting up the business offices of Stan and his business partner in a new building and location. I now am working there on an "as needed" basis, which so far has been "most needed EVERY day." With that said, I have resigned as the Coordinator of the Women of Tanglewood ("WOT") effective immediately.

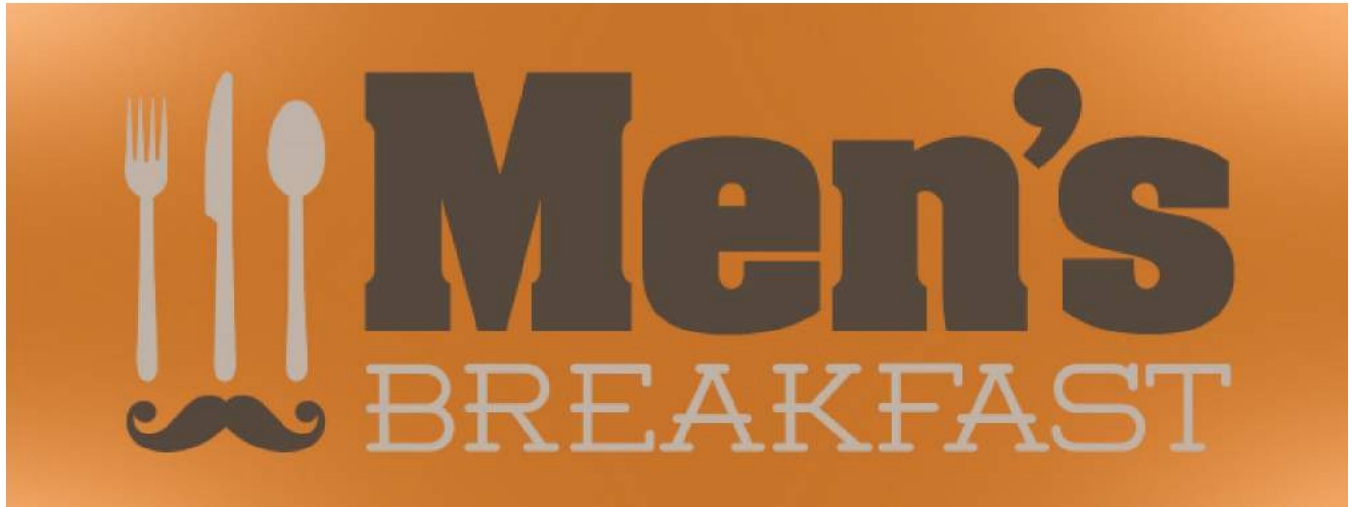

## Creamy Cucumber Salad

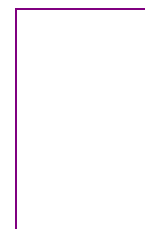
1 1/2 lbs. cucumbers (2 English cucumbers or 7-10 small ones)  
1/2 medium sweet purple or white onion, thinly sliced  
1 T fresh dill, chopped  
3/4 c. low fat Sour Cream  
1/2 T fresh lemon juice  
1 or 2 small garlic cloves, pressed  
1/2 t salt  
Pinch of black pepper

In a small mixing bowl, combine Sour Cream, lemon juice, garlic, dill, salt and pepper. Slice cucumbers into thin rounds or half rounds, if using large cucumbers. Place cucumbers and onions in a large mixing bowl. Just before serving, stir sauce and mix together coating cucumbers and onions. After adding the sauce, the salad will stay fresh for about 2-3 hours, if refrigerated.
