



Creamy Cucumber Salad

1 1/2 lbs. cucumbers (2 English cucumbers or 7-10 small ones)
1/2 medium sweet purple or white onion, thinly sliced
1 T fresh dill, chopped
3/4 c. low fat Sour Cream
1/2 T fresh lemon juice
1 or 2 small garlic cloves, pressed
1/2 t salt
Pinch of black pepper

In a small mixing bowl, combine Sour Cream, lemon juice, garlic, dill, salt and pepper. Slice cucumbers into thin rounds or half rounds, if using large cucumbers. Place cucumbers and onions in a large mixing bowl. Just before serving, stir sauce and mix together coating cucumbers and onions. After adding the sauce, the salad will stay fresh for about 2-3 hours, if refrigerated.
