

Please mark your calendars for our Women's Fellowship & Bible Study for Summer 2016.


We will meet one Saturday morning each month from 9-11 for an informal Fellowship, to include coffee and treats, and spiritual food from the Scriptures led by selected special guests.



1 lb lean ground beef

1 T Worcestershire sauce

1 T ketchup

2 T fresh minced onion

Salt and pepper to taste

4 large flour tortillas

1 c shredded Cheddar cheese

Yellow mustard

Sliced Tomatoes

Lettuce

Pickle slices

Combine ground beef, Worcestershire sauce, ketchup and onion in a medium sized mixing bowl and form into 4 individual patties. Cook patties in a skillet until. Add salt and pepper to taste. Sprinkle 1/4 c. of cheese down the center of each tortilla. Place each patty on a tortilla and top with mustard, tomatoes, lettuce, pickles, and additional ketchup if desired, and roll up burrito-style. Place wraps on a preheated indoor grill (I use my Health Grill) for about 5 minutes until cheese is melted. Cut on a diagonal and serve immediately.
