

Fresh Apple Cake (from my sister, Diane Harris) 4 c. fresh apples (peeling included - diced) 2 c. sugar 1 c. nuts (chopped) 3 c. all-purpose flour 1/4 t. cinnamon 1/8 t. salt 2 t. soda 1 c. vegetable oil 1 t. vanilla 2 eggs (well beaten) Mix apples, sugar and nuts together. Let stand 1 hour, stirring as mixture makes own juice. Sift together flour, cinnamon, salt and soda; add to apple mixture by hand (no mixer). Pour well mixed batter into greased and floured Bundt or tube pan. Bake at 350° for 1 hour 15 minutes. Test for doneness. Glaze with the following recipe: 1/4 c. frozen apple juice or drink 1 c. powdered sugar Mix well and spoon over hot cake. Tanglewood Bible Fellowship
