

What Jesus Teaches about Salvation for a Moral Religiously Orthodox Person Nobody is so good...they don't need salvation through faith in Christ **Nicodemus**: a Jew/Pharisee, Wealthy, Overly Under the Law, Outwardly Religiously Righteous, Well Thought of by Others in His Community

This Week (Letter "J" John 4:1-42 Exhibit B: The Woman at the Well)

What Jesus Teaches about Salvation for an Immoral Religiously Unorthodox Person Nobody is so bad...they can't have salvation through faith in Christ **The Woman at the Well**: A Woman, a Samaritan/Outcast, Poor, Not Under the Law, Not Religiously Righteous, Not Well Thought of in Her Community (and Hated by Good Jews)

Jive at Jacob's Well John 4:1-42 Salvation for an Immoral/Religiously Unorthodox Person

Spiritually Scandalous Setting v1-4

No "religiously righteous" Jew would set foot in Samaria! The Religious Leaders taught the Samaritans as a mixed Jewish/Gentile race with a theologically flawed religious system 1: were outside of God's saving concern and 2: had Spiritual Coodies that would rub off on and stain (otherwise) religiously righteous Jewish people.

Jesus KNEW His interaction with Samaritans WOULD infuriate the Jewish Religious Leaders and would be used by them against Him to convince "average" Jews He COULD NOT by the Messiah, but He did it anyway. The mere fact that doing the right thing will make "somebody" upset is NOT by itself a good reason to punt.

Salvation Offered to a Samaritan v5-26

The Living Word a "Merely Existing" Woman v5-15

Coming to the well at noon was just not done but this Woman was so odious to the other Samaritans, she came when she knew nobody else would be there!

Jesus is "CLEARLY misunderstood" (again-three weeks in a row! 2:19-21 and 3:3-5) Jesus is THE Giver of "Living Water" (E-Life) to All Who Will Receive It

Jesus is THE Savior of the World (Not Just of Religious Righteous Jews) v16-26

He is the Exclusive Issue/Issuer of Everlasting Life...while no one is so sinful they can't be saved, for anyone to be saved s/he must recognize their sin and their inability in order to trust in Jesus for salvation

Spiritual Lessons for Slow Disciples v27-38

The Woman Leaves (Temporarily) v27-30

Don't miss this: the woman goes back home with Living Water but without her bucket! BTW: Her initial testimony about Jesus was qualified not because of any uncertainty on her part but because she is humbly well aware of her (well-deserved) sketchy reputation and thus lack of initial credibility on this subject!

The Disciples Leary: They CLEARLY Misunderstand Jesus v31-38

Jesus is "CLEARLY misunderstood" (again 2:19-21; 3:3-5 and 4:7-15). He does this on purpose because He wants His Disciples to personally think through/wrestle with what He is teaching them so that in the end it will really be theirs = heart truth/personal conviction (epignosis) not just awareness of information Jesus said (gnosis).

Salvation "Surprisingly" Comes to Sychar v39-42

Many Samaritans believed in Jesus because of the word of the Woman v39 Many more Samaritans believed because of the word of the Word Himself v41 Bottom Line: The Jewish Messiah Isn't Just for the Jews v42

Take This To Heart


Hinduism puts people into one of four Castes (each with hundreds of jatis) but sees a certain group as so spiritually deplorable they aren't even worthy to be in a Caste.

These unfortunates are called "Outcastes."

Judaism in Jesus' day saw people including Samaritans (and Jewish "tax-collectors and sinners") as spiritual outcastes beyond the scope of God's salvation. Yet Jesus readily interacted with and offered salvation as a free gift to those who were condemned as unredeemable/beyond the grace of God by the Religious establishment!?!

Bottom Line: While our human best isn't good enough for salvation at the same time no one is so bad God can't save them...the ground around the cross is perfectly level. It transcends color, culture, country, morality and religiosity.

Who in "your world" (your circle of family, friends, neighbors, acquaintances) is "so bad" or maybe has been "so bad to you/yours" that you have either stopped praying for them to come to Christ or maybe have never prayed for them to come to the Savior? How does that mindset line up with the words and works of Jesus in John 4:1-42?
