Hey Ladies,

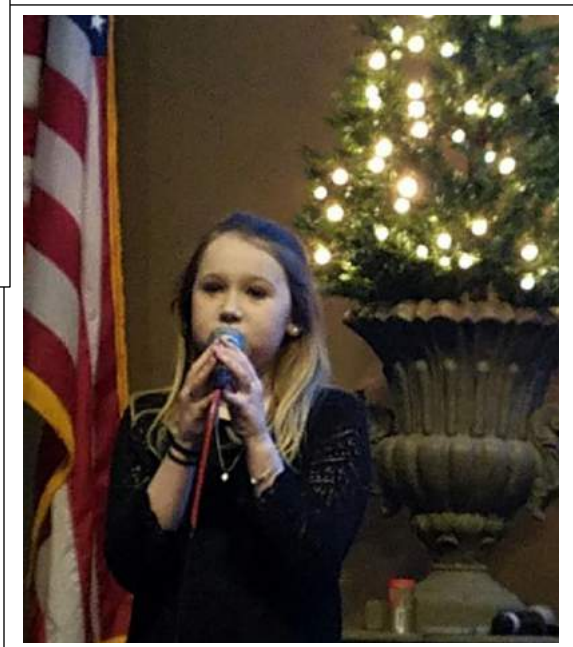
We are going to do something special from 6-8 p.m., on **Sunday, January 13th**, while the men are having their own fellowship at the Pollock's.

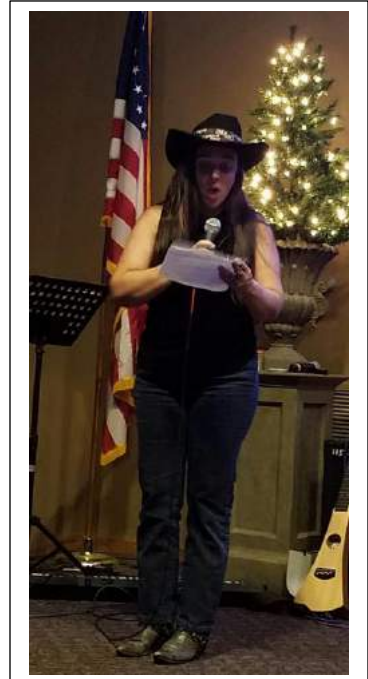

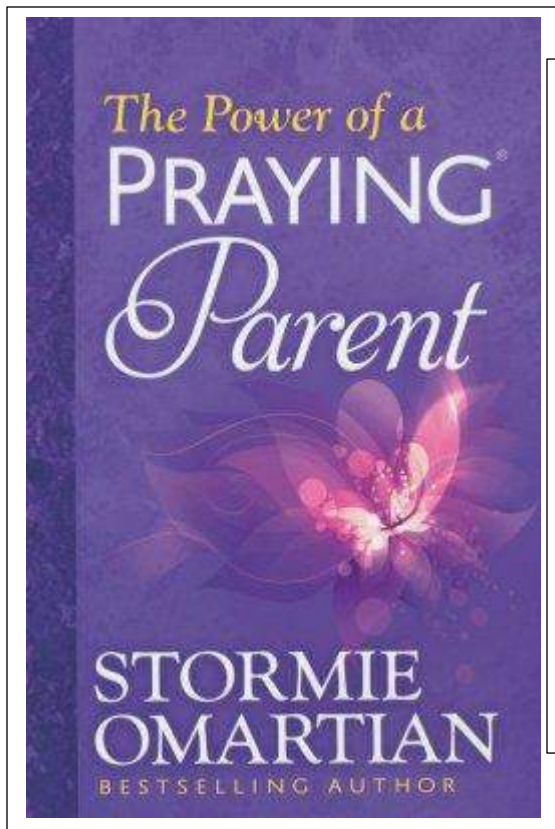

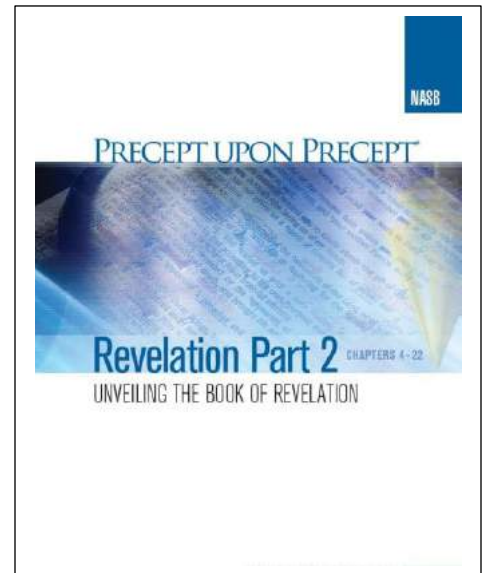
