- Isaiah 14:12-15 and Ezekiel 28:11-19
- Only possible passages
- Church tradition is united




# ISAIAH 14:12-15

- Context is King of Babylon
- Text has two meanings
- "Day Star"
- "You said in your heart, I will ascend to heaven"
- "I will make myself like the Most High"




## EZEKIEL 28:11-19

- Context: King of Tyre
- Satan created beautiful
- In Eden with glory
- One of the cherubim
- Cast into fire



#### WHEN DID HE SIN?

- Only few hints
- "from the begining"
- Had to be immediate
- Serpant = Satan
- In between Genesis 1 and 3



# FALL 2: FROM HEAVEN

- Banned from heaven forever
- Revelation 12
- At the cross and resurrection
- Or some point before the tribulation




# FALL 3: INTO THE PIT

- Bottomless pit for 1,000 years
- Some say this is now
- Temporary
- Let out briefly



#### FALL 4: INTO HELL

- Cast into lake of fire
- Final destination
- Alongside Antichirst and prophet
- Hell is not his domain



### APPLICATION
